Purpose

The Multi skilled engineers' role is to provide reactive & planned maintenance cover to all sites within Manchester, with having a usually location base. Supporting mechanical & electrically. Provide support to all sites & other cross functions where required.

Key responsibilities

- Fault finding and repair of on-line breakdowns and off-line equipment.
- To repair plant / machinery faults in a timely manner and have the initiative to request assistance if the fault cannot be rectified within a reasonable time period.
- Carry out daily inspections on guarding, belts, key assets, site facilities and complete repairs as necessary.
- Complete PMs and update the CMMS system.
- Adhere to any requirements across all sites within Manchester as required by line manager
- Planned maintenance is carried out in accordance with the schedule on the following: Conveyors, ECS', Balers, compactors, shredders, mobile shredders, electrical systems, lighting, Pneumatics and Hydraulic & more.
- Implement modifications and improvements to all levels to improve efficiency.
- To aid install of any new equipment and to relocate existing equipment throughout the site, including the installation of power supplies.
- Electrical compliance checks – PAT Testing, Emergency light checks, etc.

- Site facilities work – Repairing signage, small other tradesman ship works
- General fitting & welding duties e.g. checking and installing bearings, replacing belts, service works, shutdown days & overhauling. Ad Hoc works
